

Black Rock Creek Project

DESCRIPTION:

Black Rock Creek is a tributary to the South Fork of the Feather River. This project consisted of spot treatment of a one-mile entrenched channel with eroding banks. Large 29 woody debris and boulders were placed strategically to protect banks, reduce sedimentation and improve fish habitat.
