

Carman Creek (3 Cornered Meadow) Project

DESCRIPTION:

Carman Creek-Three-cornered meadow on the Tahoe National Forest was a collaborative project implemented by the Sierra Valley Resource Conservation District and U.S. Forest Service, with assistance from Plumas Corporation. This project restored one mile of channel, affecting 45 acres of floodplain using the pond and plug technique.

PROJECT RESULTS:

In 2006, maintenance of the valley grade structure was needed due to damage during the 12/31/05 flood event. Plumas Corporation staff assisted in the re-construction of the grade structure.
