This project entailed the use of biotechnical revegetation techniques along 500 feet of channel on Clarks Creek, within a nine acre cattle pasture on an USFS managed grazing allotment. Cattle were excluded from the site to monitor vegetative recovery results. This project was implemented as part of the Clarks 2000 plan.
