

Willow Creek Project

DESCRIPTION:

Willow Creek is a tributary to upper Indian Creek. Intervention was needed to reduce the large volumes of sediment into Indian Creek caused by 20-foot headcuts from the steep decomposed granite stringer meadow of Willow Creek. The restoration project consisted of biotechnical and step-pool headcut treatments and pond and plug re-watering.
